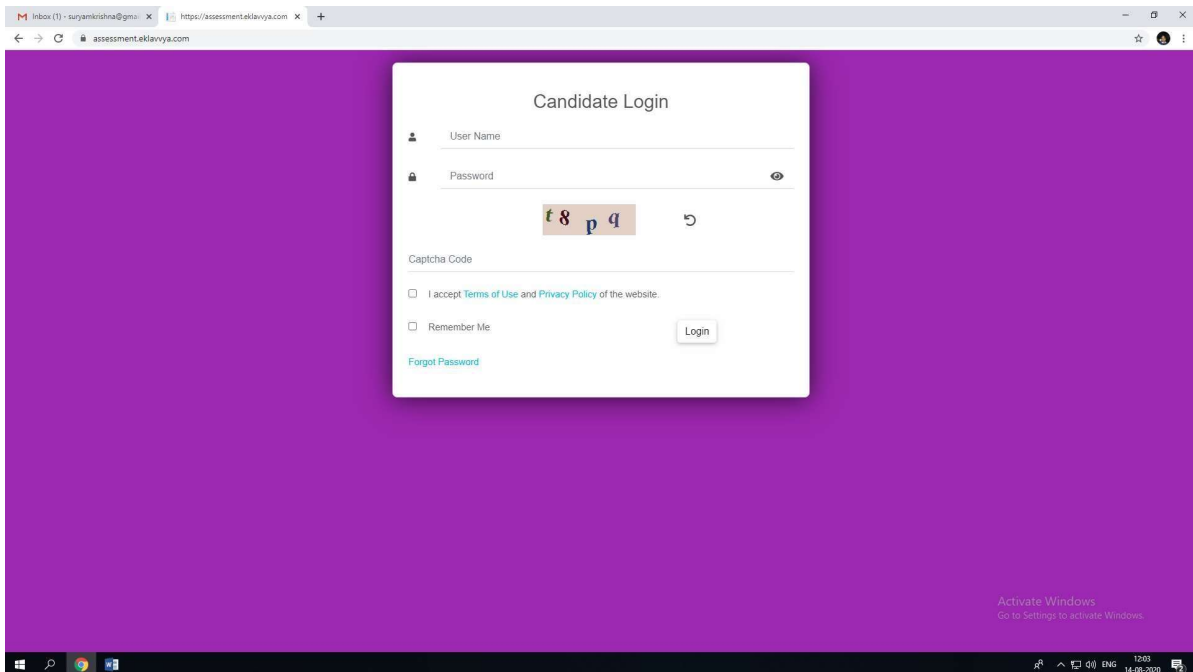

PH.D., ENTRANCE EXAMINATION-2020

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

- 1) The Ph.D., entrance examination for the year 2020 will be conducted on 23rd August 2020 between 12.30 p.m. and 2 p.m.
- 2) The exam will be conducted online and will be MCQ based with 100 questions as per syllabus given on website of the University of Ph.D., entrance exam.
- 3) The examination duration will be 90 minutes.
- 4) For appearing for online examination the candidate is required to login with credential as provided by the University between 12 p.m. and 12.10 p.m. on 23rd August 2020.
- 5) The candidate can use assessment.eklavya.com and a login screen appears as follows:



- 6) The candidate will receive an email and sms on registered email id and mobile number providing login credentials for the examination.
- 7) Once candidate enters login details, he/she will be taken to a page where the candidate will have to complete identity verification by placing their valid (Any Government Approved) identity card before the camera and clicking on Capture button. Once the photo is captured, the candidate will have to scroll down and click on confirm button and a pop up appears “your identity is under verification, please wait”.
- 8) Once the candidate is approved by the Proctor, Start Exam Button Appears and the candidate will have to click on the same and an instructions page appears and candidate will have to go through instructions and then press on I Agree button and you are ready to start.

- 9) To submit the examination the candidate will have to navigate through all 100 questions and on the 100th Question a SUBMIT Button appears and candidate will have to click on the same to end the exam.
- 10) In case if any candidate has connectivity issues in between the examination or his or her exam is stopped, they can login again and commence the exam from where they have left out.

System Requirements

- 1) A laptop/PC/ Android Mobile with latest updates of Software and also Latest updated Google Chrome.
- 2) **This is to inform you that the examination cannot be taken on an I Phone due to security features embodied on the same.**
- 3) The Mobile User has to Stop all the Notifications in mobile during the examination (Like Whatsapp / E-mail / Twitter)
- 4) If notification is on and during the exam if notification came as pop up message then it will be considered as screen sharing and you will get warning message.
- 5) Do not pick any phone call during the exam... otherwise your running exam will be disturbed and you will get warning message.
- 6) If it is found that you are taking help from others as well as you have switched the window, the same will be reviewed by the University committee and appropriate action including disqualification would be taken.
